Persecution is a normal part of following Jesus. Many of our brothers and sisters throughout the world experience all sorts of persecution for their faith in Christ. ICR supports our fellow believers as they faithfully endure persecution by meeting urgent spiritual and physical needs.



ICR is committed to seeing the kingdom of God come by partnering with local churches. This commitment is leading us to find indigenous, godly leaders who are helping to fulfill the Great Commission. Through coming alongside these local leaders and their churches, ICR is helping to ensure that they are supported as they "equip the saints for the work of the ministry, the building up of the body" (Eph. 4:12).



ICR's desire is for the glory of Christ to spread throughout the world. We long to see the gospel proclaimed to all the peoples of the earth. ICR supports kingdom advancement efforts through initiatives focused on evangelism and church planting.

WHAT IS AN AMBASSADOR?

Ambassadors mobilize their family and friends to know, pray and give to support our Christian family in places where they experience persecution. ICR commits to investing in ambassadors. Ambassadors get unique opportunities to hear speakers, specific prayer needs to pass on, and other materials to use. ICR also calls on ambassadors for help with events and meetings in their area.



KNOW

As an ambassador, you can support the persecuted by learning more about what the global church faces. ICR offers emails, newsletters, and books for more information and hosts conferences, church meetings, and ambassador meetings.

You can spread awareness through conversations and/or by hosting small events in your home or larger events at your church. You can also connect with your pastor or another church leader and share the needs of persecuted Christians. Ambassadors receive information, materials and ideas for how churches can get involved.

PRAY

One of the most effective ways to partner with the global church is to pray. ICR desires to see the church fully united in prayer, because our prayers support persecuted believers and often encourage them.

As a prayer ambassador, you will promote prayer for the body of Christ and mobilize others to pray. Each prayer ambassador receives a copy of *Pray the Word* for Your Church, along with the monthly Praise and Prayer Calendar and prayer map to help direct specific prayer. Share these reports with your family, small group, and/or church. Prayer ambassadors also receive urgent, real-time prayer requests.

GIVE

Giving is an act of worship. It is also a practical way to support the global church's urgent spiritual and physical needs. Because ICR values stewardship, over 90% of the funding that ICR receives goes directly to the field.

As an ambassador in this role, you will mobilize others to give financially. ICR presents specific, urgent needs an ambassador can take to their family, friends, and church. Another way people can serve as giving ambassadors is by hosting -- or mobilizing others to host -- fundraisers such as bake sales, garage sales, car washes, etc. ICR supplies a ariety of materials to make doing fundraisers easy, such as checklists to keep things organized. Others help organize an event at church, or can offer their homes, and invite friends and family to hear what God is doing from an ICR speaker.
