EMPOWER A CHRISTIAN WIDOW IN NIGERIA WITH A GOAT

Christian widows in Nigeria face severe hardship. Many have lost their husbands to terrorist attacks targeting Christian communities. Homes have been destroyed, livelihoods shattered, and countless families have been displaced. Because of ongoing persecution, many widows now live below the poverty line — without stable income, without security, and often without a community to support them.

Yet even in the middle of this suffering, their faith remains strong. These women believe God will provide for their families, and through the generosity of believers around the world, that hope becomes reality.

One simple gift — a goat — can change everything.

A goat provides a stable and sustainable source of income for a widow. It produces milk, has kids that can be sold, and can be used for meat, which is highly valued in local markets. With this income, mothers can pay school fees, purchase food, and begin rebuilding their lives with dignity.

One widow told us, “The mother goat has now had kids. I am very excited and hope there will be more, so I can make a living from them.” When she releases her goats to graze, they recognize her voice and return home to her — a small but meaningful picture of the restoration she is experiencing.

Through our ICR partners, each widow receives a mother goat. And to help the blessing continue, every firstborn kid is passed on to another widow, extending hope through the entire community. This simple cycle strengthens families, restores dignity, and helps persecuted believers survive and rebuild.

By empowering a widow with a goat, you are helping her provide for her children, remain hopeful, and stand resilient in the face of persecution.
